
Arnstein's Ladder: democracy maturity standards



Decidim is an open global association governed by transparent and democratic processes that take place on meta.decidim.

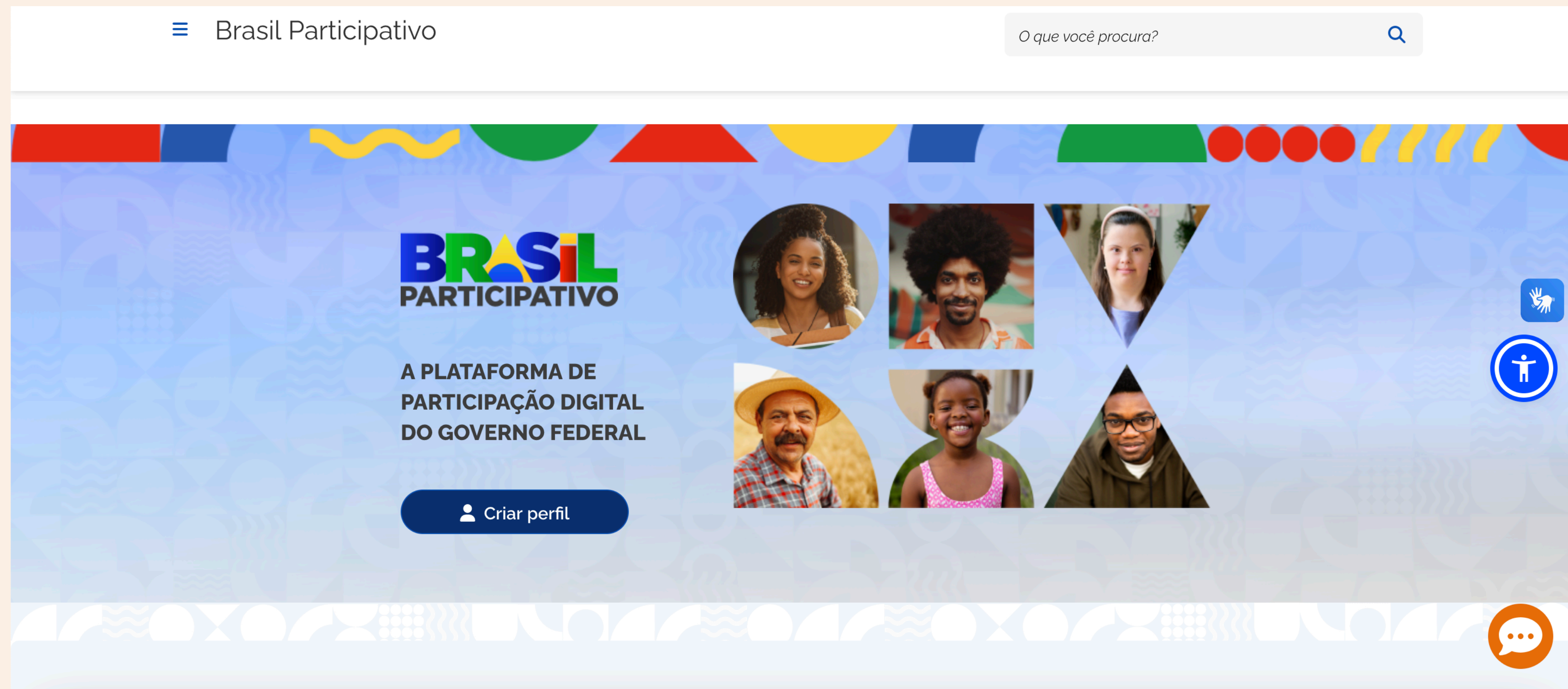
